3. Den danske Regering vil træffe de Forholdsregler, den anser for egnede, og vil samarbejde med andre Deltagerlande for at forhindre, at private eller offentlige Handelsforetagender anvender en Forretningspraksis eller slutter Forretningsarrangementer berørende international Handel, som begrænser Konkurrencen, indskrænker Adgangen til Markeder eller afføder monopolistisk Kontrol, saafremt saadan Praksis eller saadanne Arrangementer har den Virkning at forstyrre Gennemførelsen af det fælles Program for europæisk Genrejsning.

Artikel III.

Garantier

1. Den danske Regering og Amerikas Forenede Staters Regering vil, naar Anmodning derom fremsættes af en af de to Regeringer, raadføre sig med hinanden om Projekter i Danmark, som bringes i Forslag af Statsborgere i Amerikas Forenede Stater, og med Hensyn til hvilke de Forenede Staters Regering i Henhold til Lov om Økonomisk Samarbejde af 1948, Afsnit 111 (b) (3), paa henisgtsmæssig Maade maatte afgive Garanti for Valutaoverførsel.

2. Den danske Regering er indforstaaet med, at saafremt Amerikas Forenede Staters Regering til nogen Person erlægger en Betaling i US. Dollars i Henhold til en saadan Garanti, skal ethvert Beløb i Kroner eller en hvilken-somhelst Kredit i Kroner, som i Medfør af ovennævnte Afsnit tildeles eller overdrages Amerikas Forenede Staters Regering, anerkendes som de Forenede Staters Regerings Ejendom.

3. The Government of Denmark will take the measures which it deems appropriate, and will cooperate with other participating countries, to prevent, on the part of private or public commercial enterprises, business practices or business arrangements affecting international trade which restrain competition, limit access to markets or foster monopolistic control whenever such practices or arrangements have the effect of interfering with the achievement of the joint program of European recovery.

Article III.

Guaranties

1. The Governments of Denmark and the United States of America will, upon the request of either Government, consult respecting projects in Denmark proposed by nationals of the United States of America and with regard to which the Government of the United States of America may appropriately make guaranties of currency transfer under section 111(b)(3) of the Economic Cooperation Act of 1948.

2. The Government of Denmark agrees that if the Government of the United States of America makes payment in United States dollars to any person under such a guaranty, any kroner, or credits in kroner, assigned or transferred to the Government of the United States of America pursuant to that section shall be recognized as property of the Government of the United States of America.
