Repræsentationen har fra Kommissionen modtaget følgende telex citb.

Subject:

Council directive 79/409/eec of 2 april 1979 on the conservation of wild birds.

Conservation of Buksoer Odde as a site of international importance for birds.

The directorate general for the environment, consumer protection and nuclear safety has been informed that there are plans for the construction of a shortwave aerial network at Buksoer Odde. It seems that this type of construction would constitute a serious threat to the birds using the area on their migration route and would particularly affect the golden plover, a species listed in annex I to council directive 79/409/eec. Your government has not yet communicated the list

of special protection areas for the conservation of annex I species and migratory birds not listed in that annex (see article 4 of the directive and the council resolution of 2 april 1979 on the subject). I would therefore like to draw your attention to the fact that Buksoer Odde has been included by my directorate general in a preliminary list of bird areas of community importance. In the light of the available information the directorate for the environment, consumer protection and nuclear safety is of opinion that appropriate steps should be taken to undertake a full assessment of the likely effects of the project on the environment associating other departments with competence in that matter. Such an assessment should in the view of the commission also include an examination of possible alternative sites which are more acceptable from the ecological point of view.
