

Sectors Proposed for Simplification

Reason for proposing	On earlier occasions the introduction of a one-flow system in Intrastat has been suggested (in short, the system is based on the principle that each Member State involved only collects data on either import or export and consequently receives data on the opposite trade flow on the basis of data collected by the other Member States). In November 1999 the item was on the agenda at the 35th meeting in the Statistical Program Committee. Denmark still supports the idea of introducing a one-flow system, but several conditions have to be fulfilled: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The quality of the resulting statistics for each individual Member State (i.e. both flows) must at least be maintained. – Timeliness in connection with the collection and dissemination of data has to be guaranteed and for some Member States must be improved significantly compared with the situation today. – The inclusion of new Member States in the European Union must be taken into account in respect of the above-mentioned conditions.
